Class Details

Most dogs were not bred to be lap warmers; they were developed over many generations to aid humans with specific jobs. However, most family pets no longer need to herd farm animals or exterminate vermin, and not every hunting dog belongs to a hunter. Your dog may not have a job to do, but the instinct to do it is still there! This pent up energy and frustration needs an outlet, and often that outlet comes in the form of undesirable behaviors, like chewing, aggression, anxiety, or excessive barking. You can help prevent or improve these behaviors by giving your dog a more constructive outlet - one that both of you will enjoy! We offer several different sports that will help strengthen the bond between you and your pet. Confirmations will be emailed after close of registration.

Agility Classes:

Agility helps to build confidence and reinforces off-leash control. Your dog will learn to jump hurdles, go through tunnels, weave polls, and climb platforms. Basic Obedience is a prerequisite for this class. Dogs must be at least 1 year old to participate. Advanced and intermediate drop-in classes run year-round, basic classes are seasonal.

Conformation:

This class is to prepare you and your dog for the conformation ring. It will help teach your dog to stack and to hold still while being examined, as well as proper gating. Classes are drop-in and run year-round.

Competition Obedience:

Competition obedience class prepares your dog for the obedience ring. The class begins with beginner novice, and then moves on to novice, open, and utility. See AKC.org for obedience rules and regulations.

Flyball:

Flyball is a high-speed racing game between two teams of four dogs and handlers. Each dog is released on a line and runs 50 feet over four jumps to a box to retrieve a ball. The dog then runs back and returns to the handler. Dogs must be at least 1 year old to participate. Advanced and intermediate drop-in classes run year round, basic classes are seasonal.

Barn Hunt:

Pet rats are hidden in protective tubes in a maze of straw. Dog and handler must correctly locate and identify which tubes contain rats, go through a straw bale tunnel, and climb on at least one bale. Note: This sport involves live pet rats, who are not harmed or stressed during the game. No participant is required to touch or directly handle the rats, but because their safety and care is a top priority, those with rodent phobias may not wish to participate (you may be asked to hold a tube with a rat in it while a dog completes its course).
